



C502B Clock Radio with Dual Alarm

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. Read these Instructions.

5. Do not use this apparatus near water.
6. Clean only with a dry cloth.
7. Do not block any ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.
8. Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding-type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. 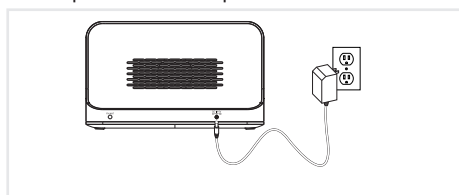


This symbol indicates that this product incorporates double insulation between hazardous mains voltage and user accessible parts.

Introduction and Setup

Power

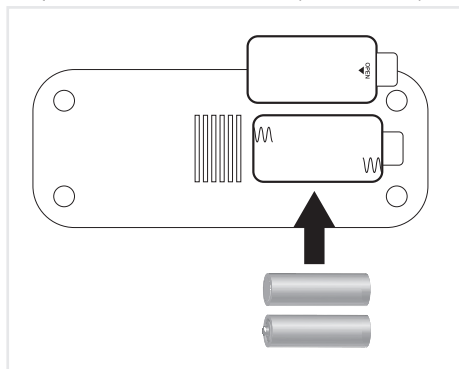
Plug the included AC/DC power adapter into the **DC POWER INPUT** on the dock and an AC power outlet to power the dock.



Battery Backup

The battery backup is intended for short power outages only. The clock radio's primary functions cannot run off of the battery backup alone.

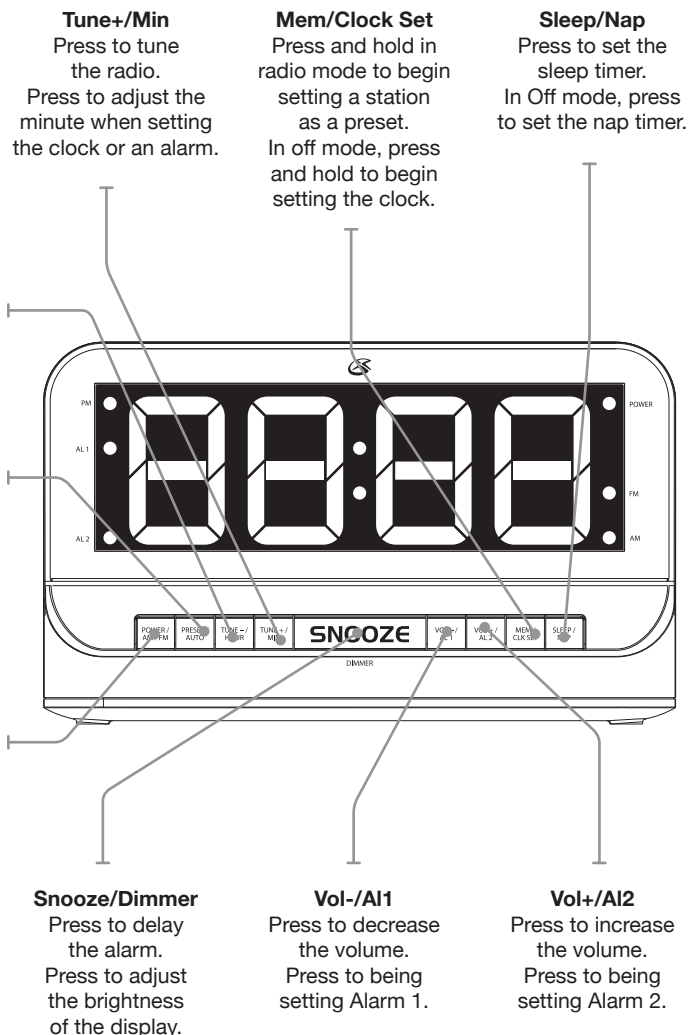
Requires 2, AA-size, batteries (not included)



Tune-/Hour
Press to tune the radio.
Press to adjust the hour when setting the clock or an alarm.

Preset/Auto
In radio mode, press to cycle through preset radio stations.
Press and hold to autosave preset channels.

Power/AM/FM
Press and hold to turn off the radio.
Press to turn on the radio and switch between AM and FM radio modes.



Clock & Sleep/Nap Timer

Setting the Clock

1. If in radio mode, press and hold the **Power/AM/FM** button to turn the unit off.
2. Press and hold the **Mem/Clock Set** button until the display begins to blink, then release the button.
3. Press the **Tune-/Hour** button to adjust the hour.
The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.
4. Press the **Tune+/Min** button to adjust the minute.
5. Press the **Mem/Clock Set** button to finish setting the time.

Setting the Sleep Timer

1. Press the **Sleep/Nap** button repeatedly to set the sleep timer (120, 90, 60, 45, 30, 15 min or OFF).
2. Once the set sleep time has expired the clock radio will automatically power off.

Setting the Nap Timer

1. Press the **Power/AM/FM** button to turn the clock radio on.
2. Press the **Power/AM/FM** button again to switch between AM and FM radio mode as desired.
3. Press and hold the **Power/AM/FM** button to turn the unit off.
4. Press the **Sleep/Nap** button repeatedly to set the nap timer (120, 90, 60, 45, 30, 15 min or OFF).
5. Once the set nap time has expired the unit will begin playing the radio.

Alarm

Setting the Alarm

1. If in radio mode, press and hold the **Power/AM/FM** button to turn the unit off.
2. Press and hold the **Vol-/AI1** or **Vol+/AI2** button until the display begins to blink, then release the button.
3. Press the **Tune-/Hour** button to adjust the hour.
The PM indicator will light when the hour is set in the PM.
4. Press the **Tune+/Min** button to adjust the minute.
5. Press the **Vol-/AI1** or **Vol+/AI2** button repeatedly to switch between Buzzer, AM radio, FM radio or Off.
When setting to Buzzer, only the alarm indicator will be lit.
6. Once the set alarm time is reached, the alarm will sound.
When the alarm is set and active, the AI 1 or AI2 Indicator will be lit.
To set the other alarm, follow the above steps and choose the alarm not currently set.

Cancelling the Alarm

1. Follow the instructions for Setting the Alarm.
2. Press the **Vol-/AI1** or **Vol+/AI2** buttons repeatedly until the indicator is no longer lit.

Snooze and Alarm Reset

After the alarm sounds:

Press the **Snooze/Dimmer** button to delay the alarm for several minutes.

OR

Press the **Power/AM/FM** button to turn the alarm off until the set alarm time is reached again.

Radio

Tuning the AM or FM Radio

1. Press the **Power/AM/FM** button to turn the clock radio on.
2. Press the **Power/AM/FM** button again to switch between the AM and FM radio mode.
3. Press the **Tune+/Min** and **Tune-/Hour** buttons to adjust the radio to the desired frequency.
4. Press and hold the **Tune+/Min** and **Tune-/Hour** buttons to search for the next available frequency.
5. Press the **Vol-/AI1** or **Vol+/AI2** buttons to adjust the volume.
6. Press and hold the **Power/AM/FM** to turn the radio off.

Saving a Station as a Preset

1. Follow the instructions for Tuning the AM or FM Radio.
2. Tune to the desired station.
3. Press and hold the **Mem/Clock Set** button to save the current radio station as a preset.
4. Press the **Preset/Auto** button to select a preset number (Ex. PO1, PO2...).
5. Press the **Mem/Clock Set** button to save the current radio station as a preset.

Autosaving Preset Radio Stations

1. Follow the instructions for Tuning the AM or FM Radio.
2. Press and hold the **Preset/Auto** button.
3. The unit will scan for an available station, and save it as a preset. It will then scan for the next available station, and set that as the next preset, continuing until up to 10 stations are saved as presets.

Tuning to a Preset Radio Station

1. Follow the instructions for Tuning the Radio and Saving a Station as a Preset.
2. Press the **Preset/Auto** button to cycle through preset radio stations.

Radio Reception

Adjust the position of the **FM Antenna** to improve FM radio reception.

An AM antenna is built into the clock radio. To improve AM radio reception, adjust the position of the clock radio.
