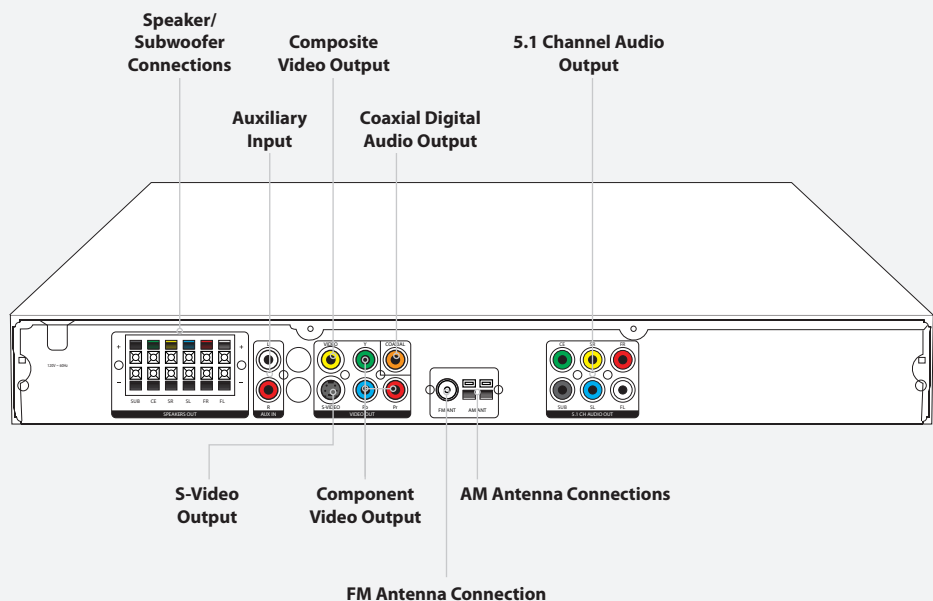
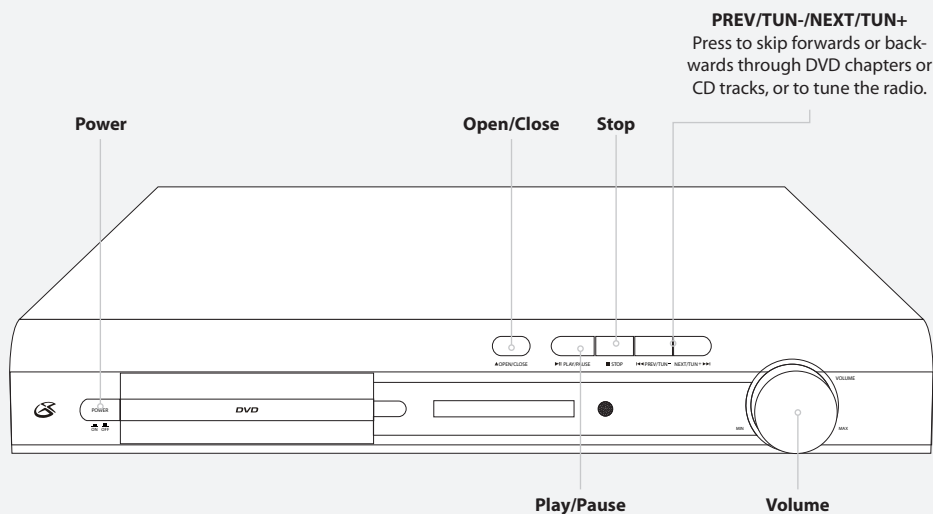

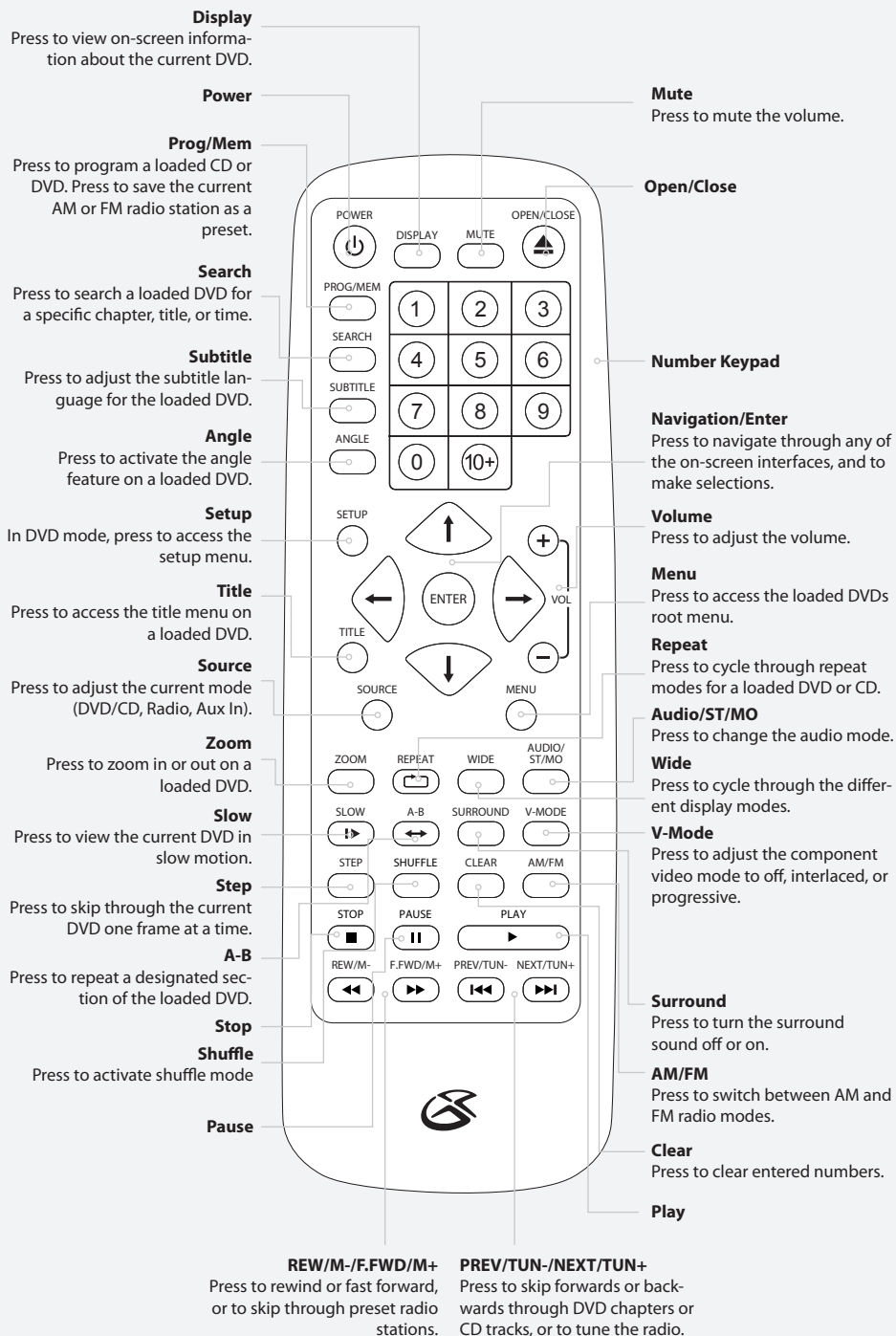

## SETUP

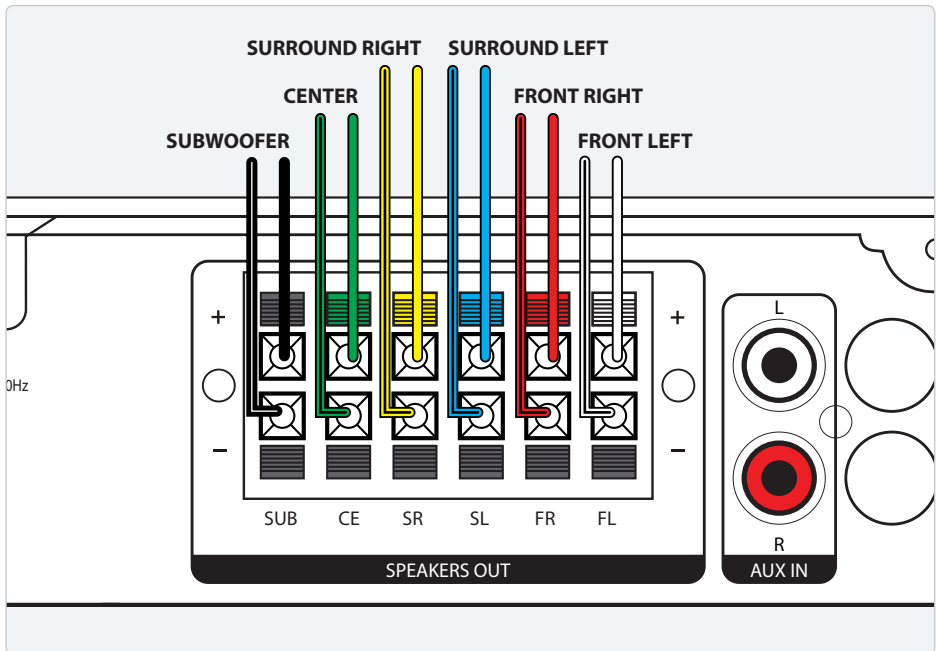
### Power

Plug the attached AC cord into a standard AC power outlet to power the home theater system.



### Subwoofer and Speakers

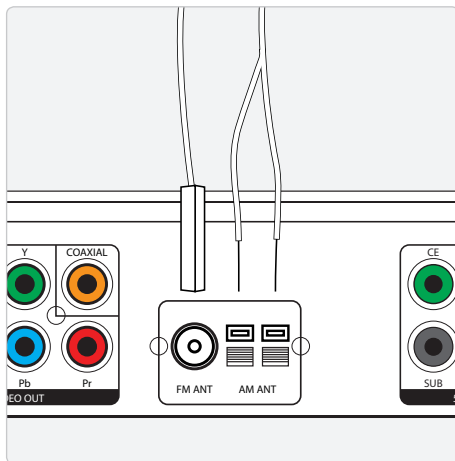
Plug the speaker and subwoofer cables into the corresponding colored **Subwoofer/Speaker Connections**.



### AM/FM Antennas

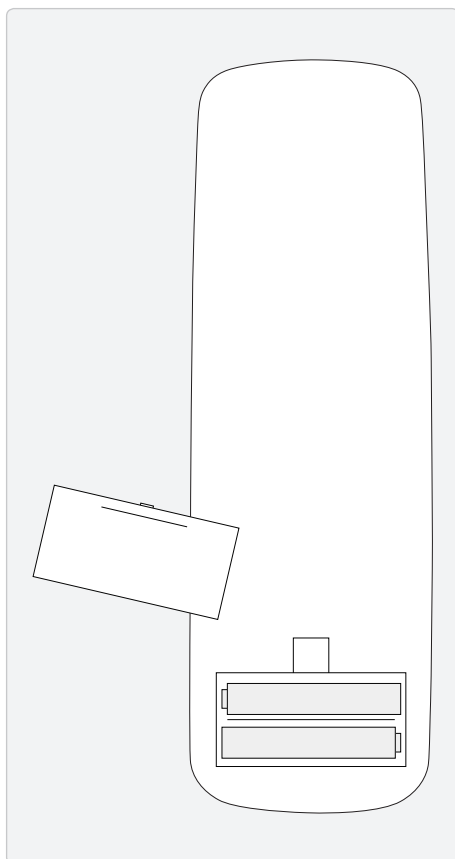
Connect the two ends of the AM Loop Antenna wire to the AM Antenna Connection.

Plug the FM Wire Antenna into the FM Antenna Connection.

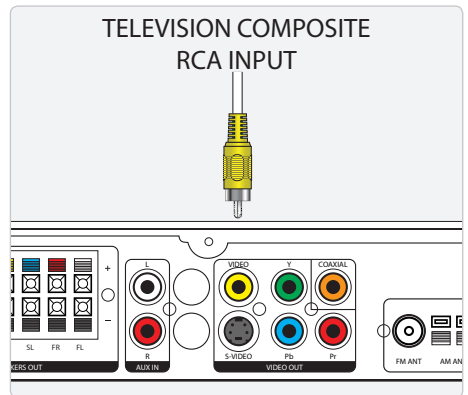

## TELEVISION SETUP

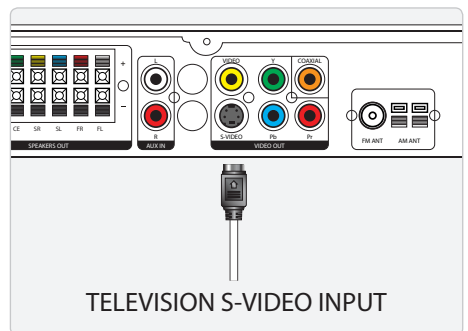
### Composite Video Setup (Good)

- 1 Connect a composite RCA cable to the composite RCA input on a television.
- 2 Connect the other end of the composite RCA cable to the **Composite Video Output** on the home theater system.
- 3 Adjust your television to the input setting that matches the connection made in step 1.



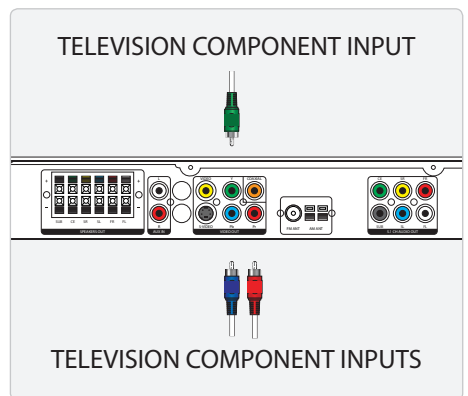
### S-Video Setup (Better)

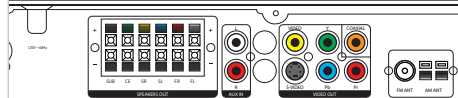
- 1 Connect a s-video cable to the s-video input on a television.
- 2 Connect the other end of the s-video cable to the **S-Video Output** on the home theater system.
- 3 Adjust your television to the input setting that matches the connection made in step 1.



### Component Video Setup (Best)

- 1 Connect a component video cable to the component inputs on a television.
- 2 Connect the other end of the component video cable to the **Component Video Outputs** on the home theater system.
- 3 Adjust your television to the input setting that matches the connection made in step 1.





- 1 Connect a stereo RCA cable to the stereo RCA outputs on a television.
- 2 Connect the other end of the stereo RCA cable to the **Auxiliary Inputs** on the home theater system.

## DVD & CD

### Playing a DVD or CD

- 1 Press the **Power** button to turn the home theater system on.
- 2 Press the **Source** button to select DVD mode.
- 3 The loaded DVD or CD will start playing automatically.

### Programming a DVD or CD

- 1 Begin playing a loaded DVD or CD.
- 2 Press the **PROG/MEM** button on the remote.
- 3 Enter in titles and chapters (DVD) or tracks (CD) using the number keypad.

*Enter these in the order you wish to watch or listen to them in.*

### Entering the Setup Menu

To enter the setup menu, you must be in DVD mode.

- 1 Press the **Source** button to switch to DVD mode.
- 2 Press the **Setup** button to enter the setup menu.

### Preference Page

To access the preference page, the home theater system must be in full stop mode or the disc drawer must be empty. Press the **Stop** button twice to enter full stop mode.

## RADIO

### Playing the AM/FM Radio

- 1 Press the **Power** button to turn the home theater system on.
- 2 Press the **Source** button to select radio mode.
- 3 Press the **AM/FM** button to switch between AM and FM radio mode.
- 4 Press the **PREV/TUN-/NEXT/TUN+** buttons to adjust the AM or FM radio station.

### Saving an AM/FM Radio Station

In order to see the current radio station preset, the home theater system must be connected to a television.

- 1 Follow the steps for Playing the AM/FM Radio.
- 2 When tuned to the desired station, press & release the **PROG/MEM** button on the remote.
- 3 Use the number keypad to enter in a preset (01-40) to save the current radio station to.

*When saving to presets 01-09, you must press the 0 button first.*

- 4 Press the **REW/M-** and **F.FWD/M+** buttons to cycle through saved radio stations.

### Auto Preset

In radio mode, you can press the **Search** button to auto scan and save radio presets.
