Note: Before use, pair the earbuds with the device. Refer to the section on Pairing a Bluetooth Device.

1. After downloading and installing the app, press the **app icon** on your phone screen to open the app.
2. The app will automatically begin to bind the earbuds to your phone. *This is a separate action from pairing Bluetooth.*
3. After binding is complete, press the **Camera** icon in the app to begin taking pictures.
4. Press the **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button to take photos.
5. Headset battery status may be seen in the icon at the top of your Android phone's screen.

CSR Easy Click for Apple

Note: CSR Easy Click for Apple iOS does not have the earbud battery status feature.

1. After downloading and installing the app, press the **app icon** on your phone screen to open the app.
2. The app will automatically begin to bind the earbuds to your phone. *This is a separate action from pairing Bluetooth.*
3. Press the **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button to take photos.

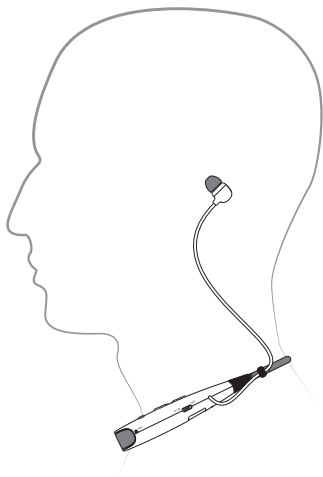

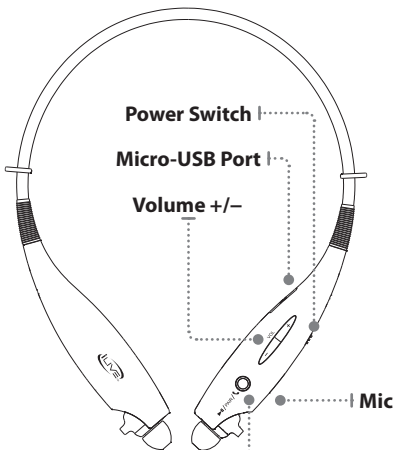

Controls



Play/Pause/ | Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie

Press and hold to pair

Press to play or pause the current track.

Press to answer an incoming call.

LED Indicators

*Note: The **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button doubles as the LED Indicator.*

Status	Indicators
Power On	Flashing blue light
Power Off	No light
Low Battery	Flashing red light
Charging	Red light
Finished Charging	Blue light
Pairing Wireless	Flashing red and blue lights

Battery Power

1. Using a **Micro-USB to USB** cable (included), connect to the USB port of a powered on computer or USB power adaptor to charge the unit. Charge fully before use.

Initial charge time is approximately 2 hours. The LED indicator will display a red light when charging, and turn blue when fully charged.

Pairing a Bluetooth Device

1. Power on the unit by sliding the **Power Switch** to the **ON** position, and press and hold the **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button for **4 seconds**. *When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.*
2. Using the controls on your Bluetooth device, select **IAEB25** in your Bluetooth settings to pair. If your device requests a password, enter the default password **0000**.
3. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices. After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device.

If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps.

Playing Audio Wirelessly

1. Follow the instructions for Pairing a Bluetooth Device.
2. Use the controls on the connected Bluetooth Device to select a track.
3. To play or pause the selected track, use the controls on the connected Bluetooth Device or press the **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button.
4. Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speakers.

Using the Speakerphone

1. Follow the instructions for Pairing a Bluetooth Device.
2. When a call is received, a ringtone will sound through the earbuds speakers.
3. Press the **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button to accept the call or accept the call using the controls on the connected mobile phone.
4. The incoming call received through the device will now be heard through the headset.
5. To end the call, press the **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button or end the call using the controls on the connected mobile phone.
6. To re-dial the last dialed number, press the **Play/Pause/Speakerphone/Pair/Selfie** button twice.

“Selfie” App

The earbuds can work with a “Selfie” app that connects to your smart phone and allows you to take camera photos using the earbud controls. Scan the QR codes below to download the app from the Google Play Store or Apple App Store.
