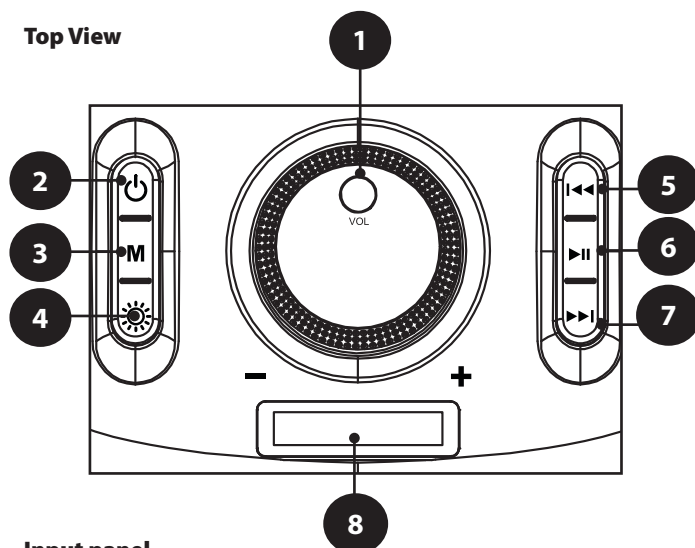

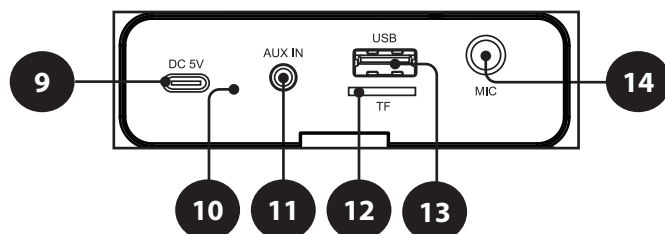
Controls and Functions

Top View



1. **Volume:** Turn the knob to change the volume. Turn to the left to turn volume down. Turn to the right to turn volume up.
2. **Power Switch:** Press and hold to power the speaker on/off.
3. **Mode:** Press to change the playback source from Bluetooth/MicroSD/USB/AUX. Press and hold for 5 seconds to turn voice prompts on/off.
4. **Lights:** Press and hold to turn lights on/off. Press to cycle through light modes.
5. **Previous:** Press to play the previous track.
6. **Pause/Play/Pair:** Press to pause or resume playback. Press and hold to manually disconnect Bluetooth.
7. **Next:** Press to play the next track.
8. **Display**

Input panel

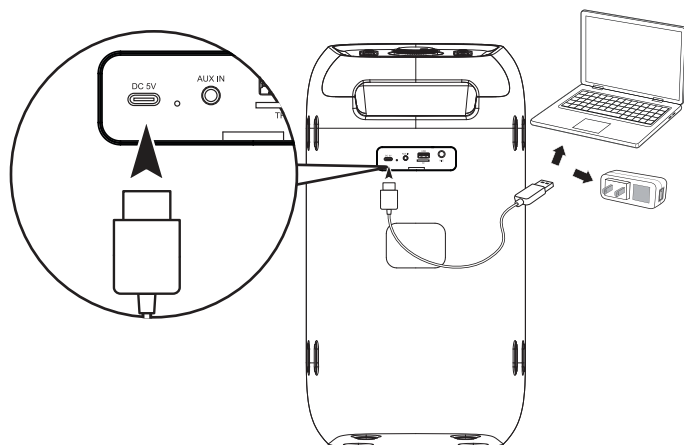


9. **DC Power Input**
10. **Charging Indicator LED**

13. **USB:** Insert USB to play stored music files. Cannot be used for charging devices.
14. **Microphone Input**

Powering the Unit

Connect the USB-C power cord to the **DC power input** on the speaker and a USB power adapter (not included) or powered-on computer. When the speaker is charging, the **Charging Indicator LED** will light up. When charging is complete, the **Charging Indicator LED** will turn off. Charge while powered off for best results.

Charge fully before use. The charge time is approximately 5–6 hours.
For best results, turn the volume down before turning off the speaker.



Bluetooth Wireless

Pairing & Playing Audio

1. When powered on, the speaker will enter Bluetooth Mode automatically. Press the **Mode** button to switch to Bluetooth if already playing from another source (USB, MicroSD, etc).
2. Using the Bluetooth setting on your device, search for new devices and select **ISB406**. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.
3. When successfully paired, a voice prompt will announce "Bluetooth connected."
4. Use the controls on the connected device to select and begin playing audio. Use the controls on the unit or the connected device to play, pause, and adjust volume.

Note: The speaker will automatically connect to the last paired device when powering on. If your device becomes unpaired or it is unable to connect, press and hold the **Pause/Play/Pair** button to enter pairing mode. A voice prompt will announce "Bluetooth is connecting." Start from step two to connect to your device.

Voice Prompts

To turn off voice prompts, press and hold the **Mode** button for five seconds. To turn voice prompts back on, press and hold the **Mode** button for five seconds.

Light Modes

Press the **Lights** button to cycle through speaker light modes. Press and hold the **Lights** button to turn Lights on/off.

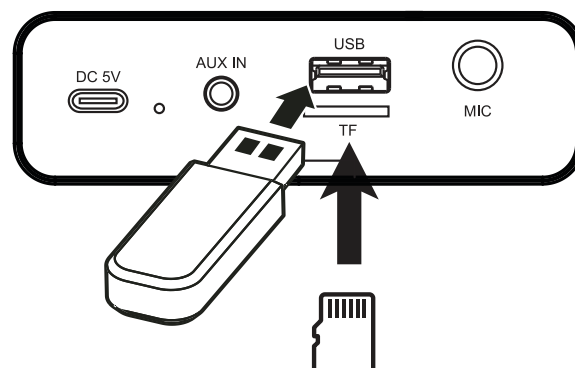

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MicroSD and USB

Supports MicroSD cards and USB Drives up to 64GB.

1. Insert a MicroSD card into the **MicroSD Slot** or a USB drive into the **USB Port** on the unit.
2. The speaker will automatically switch to **MicroSD** or **USB** mode. To enter External Media mode from another source, press the **Mode** button.



Aux In

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (not included).

1. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the Aux In on the speaker and the audio output on an audio device. The speaker will automatically change to Aux In mode.
2. Use the controls on the connected device to select and play audio. Make sure the volume on your connected device is turned up when you begin playback.
