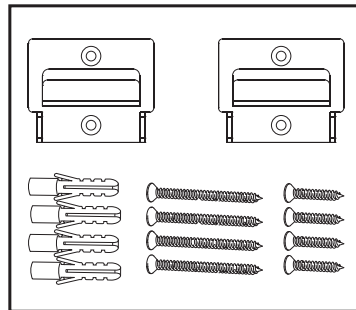

## Usability- The Learn feature

Teach your sound bar to recognize commands from a single remote

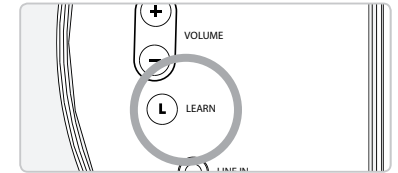
### What is the learning feature?

The learning feature captures remote commands from your television remote, and teaches your bar speaker to operate when these commands are pressed. Power, volume and mute are a few examples of commands that the bar speaker can learn.

### Why use the learning feature?

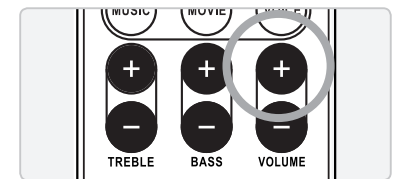
Teaching the bar speaker remote commands will reduce the number of remotes needed, save time searching for remote codes, and improve the ease of operation.

1. With the power Off, press the **Learn** button on the unit.



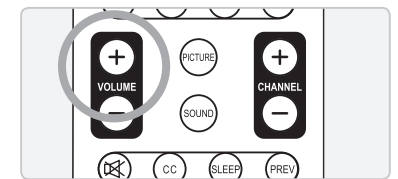
2. Press the button you desire to be learned on the included remote.

*For example: Volume+*



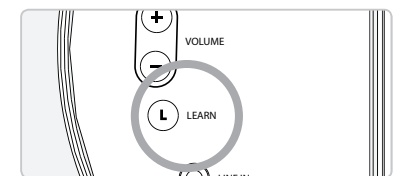
IT202B Remote
