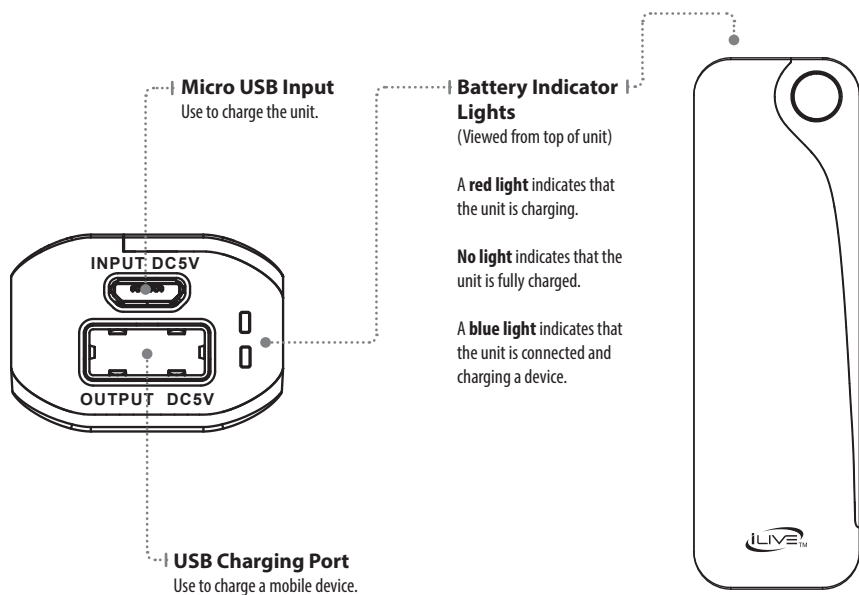

Features



Charging the Unit

1. Using a **Micro-USB to USB** cable (included), connect the larger **USB plug** to the USB port of a powered on computer or USB power adaptor.
2. Connect the smaller **Micro-USB plug** into the **Micro-USB port** of the charger. The unit will now charge, and will turn off automatically when disconnected.

Note: Charge fully before use. Initial charge time is approximately 6 hrs. Charge the unit at least once a month to maintain battery integrity, even when not in use.

Charging Devices

1. Using a **Micro-USB to USB** cable (included), connect the larger **USB plug** to the **USB Output** on the unit.
2. Connect the smaller **Micro-USB plug** into the **Micro-USB port** of the device you wish to charge.
3. The charger will begin charging your mobile device.

The unit will automatically power off after it is done charging your device.

Note: The output on this charge is 5V 1A. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for manufacturers required charging amperage as well as determining the appropriate cable for your device before charging.
