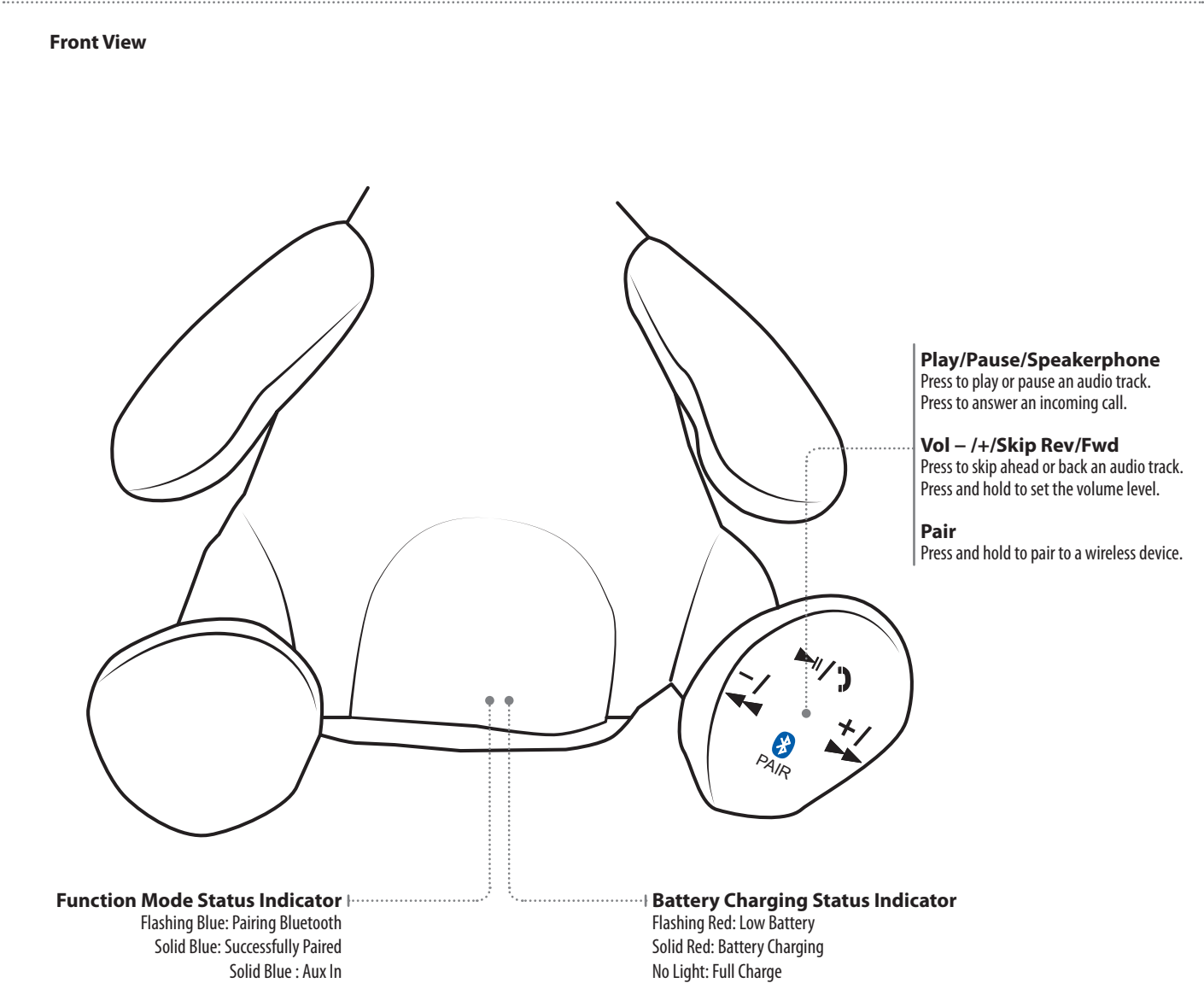

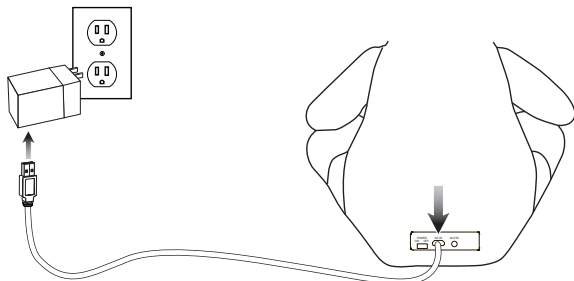
POWER & CHARGING

Requires a Micro-USB to USB cable (included).

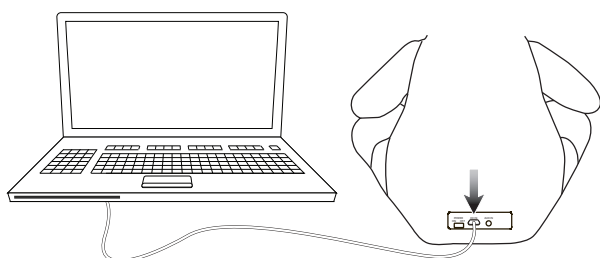
When the unit is charging, the **LED indicator** on the front of the unit **will display solid red**. When the unit is fully charged, the **LED indicator will turn off**.

1. Using a Micro-USB to USB cable (included), connect the larger **USB plug** to the **USB port** of a powered on computer or USB power adaptor (included).
2. Connect the smaller **Micro-USB plug** into the **Micro-USB port** of the unit. The unit will now charge.

Note: Be sure the computer is not in sleep mode.

BLUETOOTH

Pairing to a Device and Playing Audio

1. Power on the unit by sliding the **Power Switch** on the rear to the **ON** position.
2. This unit's default mode after being powered on is **Bluetooth Mode**. This is indicated by a **flashing blue LED light** on the front of the unit.
3. Press and hold the **Pair** button. The **blue LED light** will begin to flash quickly. When pairing, remain within 3 feet of the unit.
4. Using the controls on your Bluetooth device, scan for and select **ISB485** in your Bluetooth settings to pair. If your device requests a password, enter the default password **0000**. Refer to the user's manual for your specific device for instructions on pairing and connecting Bluetooth devices.
5. When successfully paired, the **blue LED light** will turn solid.
6. Use the controls on the connected device or the unit to select and play audio, and adjust the volume.
7. Audio played through the connected Bluetooth device will now be heard through the speaker.

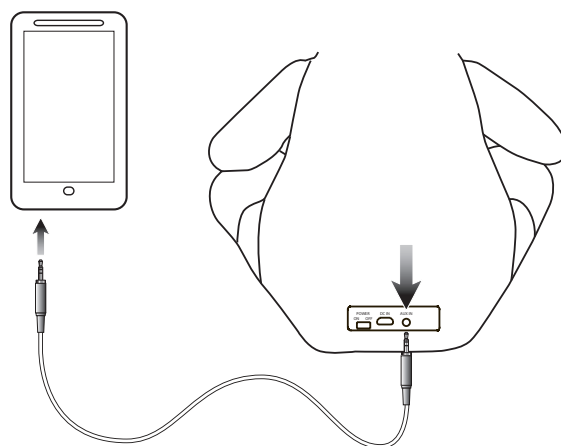
After initial pairing, the unit will stay paired unless unpaired manually by the user or erased due to a reset of the device. If your device should become unpaired or you find it is unable to connect, repeat the above steps.

AUX IN

Using Aux In (3.5mm Audio Input)

Requires a 3.5mm audio cable (included).

1. Connect a 3.5mm audio cable to the **Aux In Input** on the rear of the unit and the **audio output/headphone jack** on a media player.
2. The unit will automatically detect the input and switch to **Aux In Mode**. This is indicated by a **solid blue LED light** on the front of the unit.
3. Use the controls on the connected device or the unit to select and play audio, and adjust the volume.
